Overview

The number one cause of death from non-communicable diseases is cardiovascular diseases. According to WHO cardiovascular disease is a disease caused by impaired function of the heart and blood vessels such as hypertension, stroke, ischemic heart disease and heart failure. Early death or death before the age of 60 years reported incidence reached 30% in developed countries and in developing countries reached

WHO reported the number of deaths caused by heart disease each year to reach 17.5 millions. The deaths due to stroke and coronary heart disease can reach 80%. Almost 75% of deaths from cardiovascular disease occur in developing countries, including Indonesia. Deaths caused by cardiovascular diseases, especially coronary heart disease and stroke is expected to continue to increase to 23.3 million deaths in 2030.

In general, cardiovascular disease and blood vessels associated with atherosclerosis

process due to diabetes mellitus, hypertension, metabolic syndrome and hypercho-lesterolemia, and obesity. Other risk factors for cardiovascular disease are age, genetic factors, gender, smoking, stress, unhealthy diet and lack of activity or exercise. The prevalence of heart disease in Indonesia average of 9.2%, with the highest prevalence reached 16.9% in Central Sulawesi and the lowest prevalence in Lampung with figures of 3.5%. The prevalence could reach 17.3% at the age of 65 years. The incidence of heart disease each year in the world is likely to increase as well as the conditions in Indonesia.
