

The DAAD Regional Office Jakarta invites you to the upcoming *SCIENCE talks in DAAD Jakarta* on 28 April 2016 at **18:30** in the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany, Jakarta.

We are delighted to have **Dr. Signe Preuschoft**, Head of Competence Centre Apes, Vier Pfoten in Austria, to talk about: **Family Matters – of Orangutans and Humans**". There will be Q&A after the presentation. Refreshments will be served afterwards. This event is **open for public** and **free** of charge.

In conjunction with this event, there will be an IGSP-DAAD scholarship award. We are pleased to have three DAAD-IGSP scholarship recipients and six DAAD research grants doctoral program recipients awarded this year.

Due to the regulations of the German embassy, there are steps for guests to take into account:

1. It is **necessary** to register yourself and other participants with **the names stated and photo in your personal identifications** (e.g. Driver License, ID-Card (KTP), Passport etc.). This personal identification is required upon arrival at the embassy and must be presented/showed. Please bear in mind that business card cannot be accepted.
2. **It is not allowed to take your electronic devices inside.** Provided that the number of lockers at the German embassy is limited, we highly urge to leave your electronic devices at home or in your car. Nevertheless, the DAAD will provide an additional area for safekeeping mobile phones, tablet, blackberry, notebook, laptop, etc., if required
3. **It is not allowed to park at parking lot of the embassy.** However you could park your car at the Mandarin Hotel, for instance, if possible. It is located adjacent to the embassy. Parking fee is guest's responsibility.
4. **It is prohibited to take pictures within the embassy.**
5. Unfortunately, **the embassy has no Musholla or Prayer Room.** We therefore recommend our Muslim guests to pray before entering the embassy.
6. Entering the embassy will take some time, we highly suggest the guests to arrive at **least 15 minutes** before the event starts.

Checklist *SCIENCE talks in DAAD Jakarta*:

- Registration with full name as stated on ID, occupation, institution and email (at the latest: 25 April 2016 to Olivia Sopacua: [olivia@daadjkt.org](mailto:olivia@daadjkt.org))
- Bring your Photo ID (example: KTP, SIM or Passport)
- Arrive in time (at least 15 minutes earlier – the earlier the better)
- Bring only necessary things
